

A few days later Jesus went back to his home town. So many people came to Jesus that there was no room left, not even out in front of the door. Jesus was telling them the good news when four men arrived, carrying a man who could not walk. Because of the crowd, they could not get the man to Jesus. So they made a hole in the roof right above the place where Jesus was. When they had made an opening, they let the man down, lying on his mat. Seeing how much faith they had, Jesus said to the paralysed man, "My son, your sins are forgiven."

Some Jewish teachers who were sitting there thought to themselves, "How does he dare to talk like this? God is the only one who can forgive sins!"

At once Jesus knew what they were thinking, so he said to them, "Why do you think like this? I will show you that I can forgive sins, as only God can." So he said to the man who could not walk, "I tell you, get up, pick up your mat, and go home!"


While they all watched, the man got up, picked up his mat, and hurried away. They were all completely amazed and praised God, saying, "We have never seen anything like this!"

Jesus died. He had done it. Jesus had rescued the world.




The curtain hanging in the Temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.


