Tue	<p>Badges, Bandanas, Tattoos and Names</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Get the kids to decorate/write on badges and tie bandanas. Tattoos: bowl of water and a cup. Then, play a name game: <i>My name is X. I went on a superhero adventure and I took Y with me....</i> They have to remember the name and item of children who had a turn before them. 	<p>Badges, Bandanas, Tattoos and Names</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Get the kids to decorate/write on badges and tie bandanas. Tattoos: bowl of water and a cup. Guess the Superhero The “hat” game. Each child writes the name of a superhero on a paper; folds it up and puts it in a hat (let them do 2 each). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Break them up into teams: Round 1: A team member has 1 minute to pick out names from the hat and describe them. See how many they can guess. After 1 minute, the next team has a go. Continue until you have run out of names. Rounds 2: Act it out. Rounds 3: Describe with 1 word. <p>*Play this later in the week, getting the kids to make up their own superheroes e.g. Sockman.</p>
Wed	<p>Design your own superhero</p> <p><i>Group Activity</i></p> <p><i>materials: tape, cardboard, colour bags, scissors, pens</i></p> <p>Choose a leader/child to dress up as a superhero.</p> <p>Get the children to make different parts of the costume: cape, wings, cuffs, weapons, belt, mask, logo, cap etc.</p>	
Thurs	 <p>Super hero lollies</p> <p>Make and then play a game.</p>	<p>Superhero Top trumps (DC or Marvel)</p> <p>Break kids into teams. Play against each other.</p>

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Quiz Questions

Day 2

1. Bill and Ted and finding the answers to all their assignments from one book. Which big book is that?
2. We heard yesterday that “The time has come”. Which hero has finally arrived?
3. In the Bible there are 4 true History books that tell us about Jesus’ life. They are called Gospels. Which Gospel are we learning from this week? Matthew, Mark, Luke or John?
4. When Jesus met James, John, Simon and Peter, they did the best thing. What was that?

Day 3

1. What makes Jesus a better hero than any other? *Real*
2. In yesterday’s true Bible story a man was lowered down through the ceiling. What problem could everyone see he had?
3. What was the greatest problem- which is also our greatest problem? *Older groups: you can’t write down one word- you have to say what it means.
Sin- turning our back on God, saying no to him, and choosing to live my way instead of his way.*
4. Who must Jesus be if he can solve both problems? *God*

Day 4

1. What did Jesus use when he healed the blind man? *Spit*
2. Yesterday we heard that Jesus’ hero name was the Christ. What does “Christ” mean? *Promised Rescuing King*
3. What was the second miracle Jesus did in yesterday’s story? *He healed Peter so that he could “see”/understand that Jesus is the Christ.*
4. What’s our biggest weakness? Why is that such a problem? *Sin, because it means we can’t be friends with God*

Sunday

1. Where did the greatest rescue ever to happen take place? *On the cross, (on a hill outside Jerusalem)*
2. What were the 2 signs we saw during Jesus’ rescue that helped us understand what was happening? *It went dark for 3 hours (noon- 3 o’clock) and the temple curtain tore from top to bottom.*
3. Tricky one: Can you remember what either of the two signs showed us? *Darkness shows that God was angry (with sin, and punished Jesus). The torn curtain shows that we can now be friends with God because of Jesus’ rescue.*
4. Who can be rescued by Jesus and become friends with God? *Anyone (who trusts and believes that Jesus is their King who died for the)*
