Who knows what this is? It's an Invitation to a party. Who likes parties? What do you like about parties? Food Games lots of fun. Parties are brilliant! And today's true story from the Bible is all about a King who had a great party.	Show invitation
Once upon a time there was a King.	Introduce King puppet
The king decided to have a great party. So he sent for his servant.	Introduce Servant puppet
"Go and find all my rich, important friends, and invite them to my party" said the King  The servant went off to deliver the invitations. Soon he met one of the king's friends. "The king is having a great party" he said "Will you come?" "No" said the man. "I'm much too busy. I won't come to the king's party."	Servant takes invitation and sets off.  Servant looks sad

God is like the king in the story, and the best party ever will be in heaven. God has invited EVERYONE to be there. Because God cares for EVERYONE. God doesn't just care for the rich and powerful and important people. God cares for all kinds of people – even the ones no-one else cares about. So next time you feel like you've got nothing- remember God cares for you. Next time you feel poorly and can't go to the park, remember God cares for you. Next time you feel sad and alone, remember God cares for you. And God will make sure that his great big party in Heaven will be full. You've all been invited. Make sure you're there.
