MARY Days 1-5

Cut out a crown shape from a piece of paper and decorate it because Jesus is God's promised king.

In the night, an angel told Joseph good news, "Mary's baby is from God, he is God's own son, sent to rescue us. Give him the name Jesus. His name means 'God saves." Joseph woke up happy because God was looking after him and Mary. God is still looking after us as well.



Sing 'If you're sad and you know it stamp your feet, if you're happy and you know clap your hands', because Joseph was very sad and then very happy when he heard Mary was going to have God's son.



Play a game of 'Save the toy' because it is lost! When you find it, shout hooray!

Jesus came to save people who were lost from God.

Fancy some songs and movement? Try this 23 minute Jingle Jivers session on YouTube about the wise men following the star to find Jesus.


