I KNOW GOD'S PLAN FOR MARRIAGE

This session explains that marriage is the faithful, loving commitment of one man and one woman for life and the only true home for sex and procreation.

God has designed it this way to help us understand his good, loving faithfulness to us.

























I HAVE BIG FEELINGS

This lesson aims to give children a framework for navigating strong feelings. We want them to see that their feelings aren't meant to own them or help them get what they want; they're there to lead us into what Jesus wants for us.

We look ahead to desire and sexuality without fear, knowing that we are both made to love and helped to act wisely.

























WE LIVE WHAT WE BELIEVE

This lesson aims to inspire children to 'go for it' as they live out their faith seven days a week. We want them to listen to God's voice and to be confident in the truth and goodness of his word.
