The following is a suggested verse to summarise the teaching of the holiday club. It can be introduced at any time, but will need to be used a few times over the week to ensure it is remembered.

If possible, try to think of a piece of music that the verse can be sung to, something familiar to many of the children and leaders. Alternatively, add a clapping or stamping beat to the words and teach this to the children from the front.

Think of games to aid recall as the Holiday Club progresses. Can they fill in the gap where a word is missing? Can they say alternate words across two sides of the room (with or without the words on the screen)? By the end of the week - can they do it from memory?
